## Global Read Aloud at GMA

This summer, Ms. Jen and Ms. Jamie wrote a Donors Choose grant to support the purchase of the books each classroom would need in order for our entire school to participate in this year's Global Read Aloud. This grant has made it possible for all of our classrooms - from Pre-K through Middle School - to begin this engaging project this month.

The idea behind <u>The Global Read Aloud</u> is *one book to connect the world*. Teachers make online connections with other classrooms - all over the world - reading the same book. Then, students are able to discuss the book, send postcards, meet via video call, etc. with their partner classes throughout the time that their teachers are reading aloud the selected book.
